## **CULTURE: FINALISTS OF RADUGA AWARD 2015 ANNOUNCED.**

**20 March 2015**. Today have been announced the finalists of the sixth edition of the **Raduga Award**, the literary contest for young Italian and Russian writers under 35 realized by Conoscere Eurasia Association, Headquarters in Verona and the Maxim Gorky Literature Institute in 2010. The talent and literary maturity are the main factors for selecting a winner for the Italian jury headed by Inge Feltrinelli (President of Giangiacomo Feltrinelli Editore) and for the Russian jury headed by Boris Tarasov (Docent of the Maxim Gorky Literature Institute). The award was born with the purpose to stimulate and strengthen the cultural relations between Italy and Russia, and this year the contest celebrates record of 469 participants, translators and narrators from 27 provinces of Italy and 16 regions of the Russian Federation.

The President of Conoscere Eurasia Association and Banca Intesa Russia **Antonio Fallico** says: "It's surprising to state the quality of presented works. Numerous young voices that are talking about the difficulties and uneasiness of modern society, demonstrating at the same time notable linguistic talent and gifts of interpreting the reality. This Italian-Russian project represents a unique opportunity to value and support our young generation and bring some contribution to the Italian-Russian cultural dialogue".
